

Thank you for your interest in Lansky's. Prior to making an appointment to complete an employment application, we recommend you read this pamphlet. It will provide you with an overview of the tasks and responsibilities of our workers.

Physical Demands (essential to the job)

- Eye/Hand Coordination
- Fingering (Picking, pinching, serving)
- Handling (holding, grasping)
- Wrist Motion (repetitive flexing, rotation)
- Climbing (step ladders/stools)
- Balancing
- Standing 75% of the time
- Walking 22% of the time
- Sitting 3% of the time
- Lifting 25-30 pounds (over your head)

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Workers must be able to speak, read, write and comprehend English.

Workers must understand and follow food safety guidelines in preparation, cooking, cleaning, handling and storage of food stuffs and equipment.



Duties (all workers)

- Food preparation
- Stocking (food and supplies)
- Washing dishes
- Cleaning (equipment, dining area, vacuuming, sweeping, trash removal, etc.)
- Cooking (grill, pasta station, pizza station)
- Runner (assembles and delivers food items to customers)
- Cash register



Hours of Operation/Schedule

LANSKY'S is open 7 days a week at 11 a.m.; closing times vary from location to location.

Food preparation/stocking/cleaning begins daily at 7 a.m. and after Lansky's closes for business.

Workers work a variety of hours and days. While Lansky's tries to accommodate requests for scheduling (for example, day work from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday) workers can be scheduled for early morning, evening and weekend hours.

Dress and Appearance Standards

As a customer service business and responsible for food safety, we expect our workers to maintain certain dress and appearance standards.

Career Opportunities

Lansky's encourages its employees to pursue additional responsibilities such as shift supervisor, assistant/operations manager and manager. We welcome innovative, responsible, and enthusiastic men and women to our company.
